

CALL FOR TENDER MARATHON RELAY

25TH DRESDEN-MARATHON, 26.10.2025

As a club, as a company, as a family or simply with friends - run a whole marathon once. Why not in a relay team? Train together - run together - win and celebrate together. You run on the original marathon course over 42.195 kilometres, divided into four sections between 7.2 and 13.9 kilometres - past baroque and nature, through Dresden's old town, the Great Garden and along the Elbe.

Depending on your age and fitness level, you can choose from sections of different lengths.

The highlight of your relay is the joint finish through the marathon gate of the Heinz Steyer Stadium.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE THE RUN.

REGISTRATION

www.dresden-marathon.com

Registration takes place exclusively online through a relay team captain. The team captain must be at least 16 years old but is not required to participate. By registering, it is assumed that all relay participants have read and accepted the general terms and conditions.

Each relay participant receives their own race number. The race number is non-transferable. It must be worn clearly visible and unchanged on the front of the running shirt and must not be creased or covered. Furthermore, each participant will receive a second "race number" with "STAFFEL" printed on it, which must be attached to the back of the running shirt or jacket.

Registration takes place online via the website www.dresden-marathon.com. By registering, each participant declares that they have read and accepted the General Terms and Conditions. In the case of group registrations and third-party registrations, the registrant declares that all registered persons have read and accepted the General Terms and Conditions.



The registration deadline is 13 October 2025, 24:00.

Online late registrations are possible from 14 October 2025, 0:00 to 23 October 2025, 24:00. Late registrations will be accepted on site from 24 October 2025, 15:00 to 26 October 2025, 9:30.

There is a classification for the following relays: male, female and mixed.

The eligibility to participate depends on the respective stage:

Stage 1:	13.4 km	Born in 2011 or older
Stage 2:	7.2 km	Born in 2013 or older
Stage 3:	13.9 km	Born in 2011 or older
Stage 4:	7.7 km	Born in 2013 or older

Re-registrations by name or changes to the route (always taking into account the minimum age) must be submitted by the relay team captain by 23 October 2025 by e-mail to info@baer-service.de.

Further changes and corrections can be made at the start number distribution (helpdesk) for a processing fee of €5*.

There are NO additional costs for timekeeping.

All participants who have registered by midnight on 23 October 2025 will receive a registration confirmation to the email address provided shortly before the event. When collecting the start numbers

it is mandatory to present the registration confirmation as a printout or digitally. Collection by another person is possible with a power of attorney and the official registration confirmation.

The starter lists can be viewed at www.dresden-marathon.com.

If you register by 13 October 2025, the starting documents can be sent by DHL parcel for a service fee of €15*).¹ Shipping will begin on 13 October 2025.

Upon registration, the entry fee, consisting of the organisation fee plus the fee for additional services booked, such as participation in the birthday party, medal engraving and sending of starting documents, must be paid by issuing a SEPA direct debit mandate. Incorrect details and associated fees or return transfers will be charged to the participant.

Foreign participants can choose between payment by credit card, PayPal or SEPA direct debit.

Participation in the SEPA schemes requires the payment service provider to sign the Adherence Agreements of the European Payments Council (EPC).

After registration has been completed, there is no entitlement to a refund of the registration fee consisting of the organisation fee plus the fee for additional services booked or to the issue of a voucher for a subsequent event (see General Terms and Conditions).

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION / DATA PROTECTION

Age limits depend on the respective stage (see registration).

The General Terms and Conditions of Business and Participation of Dresdner Laufevents und Touristik GmbH apply. These are available on the Internet at www.dresden-marathon.com - Information - Downloads, can be requested by post, telephone or e-mail and are available for inspection at the offices at Magdeburger Straße 2, 01067 Dresden.

Participation with inline skates or other aids is not possible. Participation with baby joggers and/or dogs is prohibited. Unauthorised bike escorts (without an official authorisation sign from the organiser) will lead to immediate disqualification of the accompanied runner.

Participation is at the participant's own risk. By registering and receiving their start number, all starters declare that there are no health concerns about their participation, that they are physically healthy and have trained sufficiently to take part in the respective competition. It is the athlete's responsibility to have their state of health checked by a doctor beforehand. The organiser accepts no liability for the participant's health risk.



The organiser accepts no liability for lost clothing or other items.

Lost property will be deposited at the information stand during the event and after the event at the office of Dresdner Laufevents und Touristik GmbH, Magdeburger Straße 2; 01067 Dresden (14 days).

STRUCTURE

Flat circuit, officially measured (DLV) and marked at 1 km intervals.

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT THE RUN

START: 26 October 2025, 10:30 a.m. (subject to change)

FINISH: HEINZ-STEYER-STADION, finish at 4.00 pm

TIMING

Timekeeping at the DRESDEN-MARATHON takes place exclusively via the RFID transponder (disposable transponder), which is integrated in the personal start number. Please attach the race number with safety pins at chest height. The race number must not be bent, covered or altered, otherwise timekeeping cannot be guaranteed. Gross and net times will be recorded. The finishers are counted according to the net time (effective running time), which crosses the start and finish as well as all control mats laid out on the course.

There is no additional transponder fee. It is not necessary to return the transponder.

LUGGAGE STORAGE

The official clothing bag must be labelled with the start number and handed in at the signposted drop-off point. Clothes bags cannot be handed in at the start! Clothes bags must be collected by 5pm at the latest. The organiser accepts no liability for damage or loss.

STARTING LINE-UP

From 10:10 am

Starting block division (see start number): A+E (Elite) / B / C.

TIME RUNNER SERVICE

In cooperation with PacerTeam.de, the organiser will be providing its tried and tested train runners for the following finish times:

3:00 / 3:15 / 3:30 / 3:45 / 4:00 / 4:15 / 4:30 hrs.



ROUTE LAYOUT / CHANGEOVER POINTS

The start numbers of the marathon relay participants differ in colour from those of the other marathon runners. This makes it possible for the stewards to point out the changeover points to the relay participants. For this reason, the race number must be clearly visible at all times.

The exchange points can be easily reached by public transport (see next page). Due to the numerous road closures, you should not attempt to organise your own transport to the exchange points.

The relay transition points are separated from the actual running course. Approx. 100 metres before the respective transition points, signs and stewards indicate the upcoming transition zone.

At each changeover point there is a "pit lane" for handing over the "baton" (transponder with Velcro tape on the foot). The allocation to the respective pits is based on the start number.

Distance 1st runner: approx. 13.4 km

Start Pieschener Allee to the changing point Straßburger Platz / Gläserne Manufaktur

Starting block allocation according to the "planned running time" of the starting runner and according to the marking on his starting number.

Distance 2nd runner: approx. 7.2 km

Change point Straßburger Platz / Gläserne Manufaktur to change point Waldschlößchenbrücke

Distance 3rd runner: approx. 13.9 km

Change point Waldschlößchenbrücke to change point Straßburger Platz / Gläserne Manufaktur

Distance 4th runner: approx. 7.7 km

Changeover point Straßburger Platz / Gläserne Manufaktur to finish Heinz-Steyer-Stadion

Joint finish: At kilometre 41.7 it is possible for runners 1-3 to join the final runner and cross the finish line together. To do this, the 3rd runner would have to take the tram from Straßburger Platz to Postplatz (approx. 6 min journey time). From there you can reach the entry point (yellow/blue beach flag "MEETING POINT"), Terrassenufer near the Semperoper after a walk of approx. 500 metres. It is then only a 450m walk to the finish.

The finish is at 16:00. The event period is limited in time and the road closures on the running course only exist within the specified running times

Travelling to and from the exchange points is by public transport. The start number is valid as a ticket on the day of the marathon. Please note: Please allow sufficient time on the day of the race, as there may be delays due to road closures.

The interchange 1+3 (Straßburger Platz / Gläserne Manufaktur) can be reached from Postplatz by tram lines 1, 2, 4, 12.

You can reach **interchange 2** (Waldschlößchenbrücke), for example, from the stop "Kongresszentrum" / Haus der Presse" by tram line 11 (approx. every 15 minutes, journey time approx. 20 minutes).

ATTENTION: Line 11 does NOT run from 10.30 am to approx. 11.15 am.



CHANGE OF CLOTHING AND TRANSPORT

The clothing drop-off point for the "pre-race" clothing of runner 1 and the "post-race" clothing of runner 4 is located in the finish area. The clothing bags can be stored there until 5.00 pm on the day of the marathon. The transport of the clothing bags to the transition zones must be arranged individually, there is no possibility of organised transport. We recommend the following procedure for the team:

Runner 1 has the opportunity to hand in a clothing bag with his "pre-race" clothing. A second clothing bag must be packed for the "post-race" clothing and labelled with the start number. Runner 2 transports this bag to the transition area and hands it over to the short time storage. It is imperative that it is labelled with the race number! Runner 1 takes his own bag after his run and, if necessary, a bag with the "pre-run" clothing from runner 2. These bags can be handed in again in the finish area so that there is the possibility of crossing the finish line together.

Runner 2 takes a clothes bag with the "NachLauf" clothes for runner 1 to the transition area Straßburger Platz. There you have the possibility to hand in a bag with "pre-race" clothes, which runner 1 will then take to the finish. It is imperative that it is labelled with the start number! Runner 2 must hand over a second clothing bag with his "post-run" clothing to runner 3 before the race. He will receive this back in the Waldschlößchenbrücke transition area at the short-term storage area. Runner 2 takes his own bag after his run and, if applicable, a bag with the "pre-run" clothing from runner 3. These bags can be handed in again in the finish area so that there is the possibility of crossing the finish line together.

Runner 3 takes a clothing bag with the "NachLauf" clothing for runner 2 to the Waldschlößchenbrücke transition area. At the same time, he hands over a clothing bag with his own "NachLauf" clothing to runner 4 before the run. This bag will be returned to him after his run at the short time storage of the transition area Straßburger Platz. He can hand in his "pre-run" clothing at the Waldschlößchenbrücke transition area. After his run, runner 3 will receive his bag with his "NachLauf" clothing and, if applicable, a bag with the "VorLauf" clothing of runner 4 in the short time storage area. It is essential to ensure that the bag is labelled with the run number! These bags can be handed in again in the finish area so that there is the possibility of crossing the finish line together.

Runner 4 takes a clothing bag with the "NachLauf" clothing for runner 3 to the transition area Straßburger Platz. His own "NachLauf" clothing can be stored in the finish area at the general clothing drop-off point. At the transition area Straßburger Platz, runner 4 can hand in a 2nd clothing bag with his "pre-run" clothing. Runner 3 transports this bag to the finish. If a joint finish is intended, this bag would have to be carried to the finish for the last few metres, as there may not be enough time to hand in the bag at the finish area.



INTERESTING FACTS AFTER THE RUN

MEDAL ENGRAVING / PHOTO SERVICE

Personalised medals can be engraved in the finish area. You can book this service when you register ($\le 30^*$). A medal symbol will then be printed on your race number. Please show your race number at the medal engraving. If you decide at short notice, you can also pay in cash on site ($\le 40^*$).

SHOWERS / CHANGING ROOMS / TOILETS

Showers, changing rooms and toilets are available in the finish area. You will find up-to-date information and a map on the runner information sheet that comes with your race number.

EVALUATIONS / AWARDS

All runners receive a medal at the finish line.

The overall winners of the marathon will be honoured at around 13:15 (men) and 13:50 (women).

The age group award ceremonies will begin at 2.30 pm.

The results lists and certificates can be downloaded and printed from the Internet.
